CUT OFF TIMES

For both events the cut off will be 10:30am.

ONLINE REGISTRATIONS ONLY

Online registrations close Thursday, 2 May at 12:00 noon sharp. Late registrations may be available on Saturday 4th May at bib collection.

BIB COLLECTION

Your bib number allocation email will be sent on Thursday, 2 May after online registrations close.

Bib collection times are as follows:

Saturday 4 May - E Shed, Victoria Quay 10:00am - 1:00pm

Sunday 5 May - E Shed, Victoria Quay 7:00an - 7:55am

Event shirts for those in the first 500 registered can be collected at this time.

Note: If required, someone may collect your race pack on your behalf.

FINISHER MEDALS

All finishers in the 5km, 10km and Kids Dash will receive a finisher medal as they cross the line!

VOLUNTEERS

BAG DROP

There will be a bag drop at the finish area. Whilst all care will be taken to ensure security of your belongings, we cannot take responsibility for lost or stolen goods.

FREE EVENT T-Shirt

For participants lucky enough to be the first 500 registered will receive an event shirt. These are only available at bib collection. Those eligible for a free event shirt will receive an email. Shirts will be given out on a first in, first served basis for size purposes. Shirts are not for sale.



KIDS DASH

A fun and **free** event for kids under 12 years old who want to show off their speed and agility. With a 300m dash, this is the perfect distance for kids to challenge themselves and have fun. We encourage all participants to register online by 12 noon, Thursday, 2 May.



DRINK STATIONS

There will be drink stations on course, manned by volunteers from the West Australian Marathon Club. There will also be water and recovery food at the finish line.

PRESENTATIONS & PRIZE DRAW

5km Presentation will commence at 8:40am

10km Presentation will commence 10:15am

Prize Draw will be after the 10km presentations.

Trophies will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd & 3rd Male & Female and 1st Male & Female U16 in both distances.

WAVE STARTS

Individuals will need to self-seed. All times are calculated from the moment you cross the start line.

TIMING

All registered participants in the event will have an electronic time recorded by Bluechip Timing. Your results will be available on the Bluechip website (www.bluechiptiming.com.au) Immediately after you cross the finish line.

Participants in the 5km & 10km will all receive a gun time and net time.





Disposable timing chips are attached to the back of the race bib. Do not remove or peel the plastic timing devices from the race bib. Attach the race bib to the front of the body only, by pinning the bib in the holes at the four corners. Please make sure that the race bib is kept flat and not folded or crumpled. The race bib is allocated to the person nominated on the entry form and is non-transferable to another person. The race bib must remain in its issued form.

All participants are required to collect bibs on bib collection prior to event day. You may nominate someone to collect your bib if you are unable to attend during bib collection times.

Note: WAMC Members, your WAMC shoe timing chip will not work at this event.

DISTANCE CHANGES

If you wish to change the distance you have entered, please notify the WAMC office before 12:00 noon, Thursday 2 May to allow time for processing.

FIRST AID

First Aid will be located at the finish line. If you require first aid assistance on course, please notify a drink station attendant or course marshal who will be able to phone for help.

HEALTH & SAFETY

Entrants must not take pets on the run. Skateboards, rollerskates / rollerblades or similar devices are strictly forbidden due to the risk of injury to participants. Be aware we may not have exclusive use of some of the shared paths.

All runners will assemble in the advised start area by foot and obey Police and Officials' directions whilst awaiting the official start.

To ensure your safety and that of everyone else in the race, the use of headphones or any musical device is strongly discouraged. Use of headphones is a safety hazard as it may compromise a participant's ability to hear critical safety and/or directional instructions, especially instructions that may arise in an emergency

TRAVEL & PARKING

Runners are encouraged to carpool or travel by train, with Fremantle Railway Station just 300m from the start line. Trains arriving at Fremantle from 7.15am.

Bag drop is available in E Shed, so bring a jumper so you can enjoy the post-race entertainment on Victoria Quay.


